MARANA ORDINANCE NO. 2019.002

RELATING TO MARANA REGIONAL AIRPORT; AMENDING MARANA TOWN CODE TITLE 15 (MARANA REGIONAL AIRPORT), CHAPTER 15-2 (GENERAL USE OF AIRPORT); REVISING SECTION 15-2-20 (COMMERCIAL PHOTOGRAPHY OR FILMING); AND DESIGNATING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS A.R.S. § 28-8411 authorizes the Town Council of the Town of Marana to undertake all activities necessary to acquire, establish, construct, own, control, lease, equip, improve, maintain, operate and regulate an airport; and

WHEREAS A.R.S. § 28-8419 authorizes the Town Council to adopt rules for the use of airport facilities; and

WHEREAS the Town Council finds that the airport rules and regulations established by this ordinance are necessary for the public health, safety and general welfare of the Town of Marana.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MARANA, as follows:

SECTION 1. Marana Town Code Title 15 (Marana Regional Airport) is hereby amended to revise section 15-2-20 (Commercial photography or filming) as follows (with deletions shown with strikeouts and additions shown with double underlining)

15-2-20 Commercial photography or filming

No person may <u>engage in filming activity</u>, as <u>defined in chapter 9-12 of this code</u>, take still, motion or sound pictures, of or at the airport, for commercial purposes, without first applying for a <u>film</u> permit <u>from the airport director pursuant to chapter 9-12</u> and paying applicable fees for the activity.

SECTION 2. The various town officers and employees are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary or desirable to give effect to this ordinance.

SECTION 3. All ordinances, resolutions, or motions and parts of ordinances, resolutions, or motions of the Council in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed, effective as of the effective date of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, the decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall become effective on the thirty-first day after its adoption.
