Recognizing Lineworker Appreciation Day

WHEREAS, lineworkers are often first responders during storms and other catastrophic events, working to make the scene safe for other public safety heroes and to restore power to the communities they serve; and

WHEREAS, lineworkers work with thousands of volts of electricity atop power lines 24 hours a day, 365 days a year, in order to keep electricity flowing; and

WHEREAS, lineworkers must often work under dangerous conditions far from their families to construct and maintain the energy infrastructure of the State of Arizona and United States of America; and

WHEREAS, lineworkers put their lives on the line every day without asking for recognition or acclaim; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Marana joins other communities in recognizing and celebrating the lineworker profession and in honoring those who selflessly perform dangerous work every day to ensure we receive the electricity we depend on.
