

MARANA ORDINANCE NO. 2022.001

RELATING TO PROCUREMENT; REVISING MARANA TOWN CODE TITLE 3 (ADMINISTRATION); REVISING CHAPTER 3-4 (PROCUREMENT); REVISING SECTION 3-4-5 (DEFINITIONS) TO DELETE DEFINITIONS AND TO ADD A NEW DEFINITION; REVISING SECTION 3-4-7 (TOWN COUNCIL APPROVAL) TO INCREASE PURCHASE AMOUNTS REQUIRING TOWN COUNCIL APPROVAL; REVISING SECTION 3-4-8 (TOWN MANAGER APPROVAL) TO INCREASE AND DIVERSIFY THE LIMITS FOR APPROVAL OF A PURCHASE BY THE TOWN MANAGER; REVISING SECTION 3-4-19 (SMALL PURCHASES) TO INCREASE THE AMOUNT FOR A SMALL PURCHASE PROCUREMENT PROCEDURE AND TO INCREASE THE AMOUNT FOR ADOPTED OPERATIONAL PROCEDURES; AND DESIGNATING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MARANA, as follows:

Section 1. The revisions to the Marana Town Code Title 3 (Administration), Chapter 3-4 (Procurement), one paper copy and one electronic copy of which are on file in the office of the Town Clerk of the Town of Marana, Arizona, which was made a public record by and attached as Exhibit A to Resolution No. 2022-007 of the Town of Marana, Arizona, and is hereby referred to, adopted and made a part of this ordinance as if fully set out here.

Section 2. The various town officers and employees are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary or desirable to give effect to this ordinance.

Section 3. All ordinances, resolutions, or motions and parts of ordinances, resolutions, or motions of the Council in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed, effective as of the effective date of this ordinance.

Section 4. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, the decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.


Section 5. This ordinance shall become effective on the thirty-first day after its adoption.


