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## NATIVE PLANT PERMIT PROCEDURAL GUIDE

### General Information

The Town of Marana has determined that native vegetation is a unique natural resource which promotes the economic and aesthetic well-being of the community. Title 17 of the Town of Marana Land Development Code identifies requirements for the protection of native plants. It establishes a native plant permit process by which all protected native plants remain in place or are authorized to be removed, relocated or destroyed.

### Pre-application Meeting

The native plant permit submittal will be discussed at a pre-application meeting which is required for any development submittal in order to assist the owner or applicant with the project and review procedures. Submittal fees will be in accordance with the applicable fee schedule. Please call (520) 382-2600 to schedule the pre-application meeting.

### Approval Process

Upon submittal of a completed application, the Planning Department will review the native plant permit and supporting documents and also distribute the plan submittal to other departments and agencies, as necessary.

Review comments are made available on-line as they are completed. The applicant is responsible for submitting a revised plan that addresses all review comments.

Once planning staff has determined that the proposed native plant permit plan is in compliance with all Town requirements, it will be approved administratively. Approval of the native plant permit shall become null and void in six (6) months if work does not commence.
