WHEREAS, September 17, 2026, marks the 239th anniversary of the signing of the Constitution of the United States of America by the Constitutional Convention; and

WHEREAS, the observance of Constitution Week provides an opportunity to reflect upon the principles and freedoms established by this historic document and their enduring significance to our nation; and

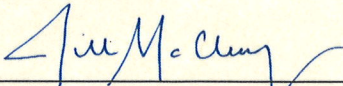
WHEREAS, Public Law 915, approved in 1956, authorized and requested the President of the United States to designate September 17 through September 23 of each year as Constitution Week; and

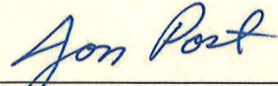
