WHEREAS, state and local governments are responsible for designing, constructing, reconstructing, operating, and maintaining transportation systems, water and wastewater systems, public parks, public buildings, and other structures and facilities essential to serving their citizens; and

WHEREAS, the efficiency of the qualified and dedicated personnel who staff public works departments is materially influenced by the understanding of informed citizens regarding the important work they perform; and

WHEREAS, the year 2023 marks the 63rd Annual National Public Works Week. The theme for this week is "Connecting the World Through Public Works," which highlights how public works connects us all through infrastructure and service, enhancing the quality of life for the communities these professionals serve; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Ed Honea, Mayor of the Town of Marana, do hereby proclaim May 21–27, 2023 as National Public Works Week and call upon all citizens and civic organizations to acquaint themselves with the issues involved in supporting public works and to recognize the contributions that public works personnel make to provide the infrastructure required to sustain the comfort, health, safety, and well-being of our community.
