



PROCLAMATION DRINKING WATER WEEK

WHEREAS, water is our most valuable natural resource; and

WHEREAS, only tap water delivers public health protection, fire protection, support for our economy, and the quality of life we enjoy; and

WHEREAS, any measure of a successful society – low mortality rates, economic growth and diversity, productivity, and public safety – are in some way related to access to safe water; and

WHEREAS, we are all stewards of the water infrastructure upon which future generations depend; and

WHEREAS, Marana Water provides public drinking water to a range of places, including schools, parks, local businesses, places of worship, healthcare facilities, and customer's homes; and

WHEREAS, each citizen of the Town is called upon to help protect our source waters from pollution, to practice water conservation, and to get involved in local water issues by getting to know their water;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved, the Mayor and Council of the Town of Marana hereby proclaim May 3rd through May 9th, 2020 as
