

DO I NEED A CERTIFICATE OF OCCUPANCY FOR MY BUSINESS?

Depending on the previous tenant and whether you plan to make improvements to the space and/or building, you may need a Tenant Improvement permit, a Certificate of Occupancy, or both. See the chart below for more information.

If your business is moving into an existing building or suite, replacing a business with the same use (e.g. restaurant replacing a restaurant)

AND you are making no improvements to the building:





Same Use No Improvements

The existing Certificate of Occupancy is valid and no permit is needed.

If your business is moving into an existing building or suite, replacing a business with a different use (e.g. restaurant replacing a flower shop) AND you are making no improvements to the building:





Different Use No Improvements

A Change of Occupancy permit is required to receive a valid Certificate of Occupancy.

If you are remodeling or otherwise making improvements to a new or existing building or suite, regardless of your business's use or the use formerly in the same space:





Same or Different Use With Improvements

A Tenant Improvement permit is required for the improvements and to receive a valid Certificate of Occupancy.
