MARANA ORDINANCE NO. 2023.039

RELATING TO PARKS AND RECREATION; REVISING MARANA TOWN CODE TITLE 13 (PARKS & RECREATION), CHAPTER 13-1 (PARKS AND RECREATION REGULATIONS); SECTION 13-1-1 (DOMESTIC ANIMALS AND PETS) TO REFER TO DOG PARK DEFINITION AND REGULATION IN TITLE 6 (ANIMAL CONTROL); AND DESIGNATING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MARANA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Marana Town Code Title 13 (Parks and Recreation), Chapter 13-1 (Parks and Recreation Regulations), Section 13-1-1 (Domestic animals and pets) is hereby amended as follows (with additions shown with <u>double-underlining</u>):

13-1-1 Domestic animals and pets

[No revisions to paragraphs A through D]

<u>E. Owners and dogs within a town-maintained dog park, as defined by chapter 6-1 of this code, must comply with chapter 6-4 of this code.</u>

SECTION 2. The various town officers and employees are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary or desirable to give effect to this ordinance.

SECTION 3. All ordinances, resolutions, or motions and parts of ordinances, resolutions, or motions of the Council in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed, effective as of the effective date of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, the decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be effective on the 31st day after its adoption.
